# GOLD MEDAL & AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

## Information for Entrants

The General Conditions for Competitions (GCC) of the Devon County Golf Union apply to this competition. Refer to your club, the DCGU Website or the current DCGU Yearbook.

### 1 CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- a) **Golf Medal Format:** The competition shall be decided by stroke play over 36 holes
- b) **Winner:** The Winner shall be the competitor who returns the lowest gross score
- c) **Resolution of Ties:** In the event of a tie, the competition shall be decided by play-off
- d) **Qualifying Events:** Entrants have the option at the time of entry to play in the ensuing match play stages for the Amateur Championship or "Wish Slater Salver".
- e) **Match Play Stages** - The first 16 players from the Gold Medal play singles knockout Matchplay on Saturday and Sunday to determine the County's Amateur Champion. The second 16 players from the Gold Medal play singles knockout Matchplay on Saturday and Sunday to determine the winner of the "Wish" Slater Salver
- f) **Distance Measuring Devices (DMD)** - In all DCGU Strokeplay & Matchplay Competitions inc. Order of Merit Events, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind- speed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14 – 3, **for which the penalty is disqualification**, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.  
**Note (i)** - Trolleys with a distance-measuring capability may be used provided any other features, which are non-conforming, are disabled (e.g. 'taped up' or switched off).  
**Note (ii)** - Mobile phones with a distance-measuring application may be used provided the application is restricted to "distance only" and the phone does not have any other "non-conforming" features.

### 2 QUALIFICATION

- a) Entrants must have a playing CONGU handicap not exceeding that specified on Entry Form
- b) Entrants must either be members of Devon Affiliated Clubs or members of clubs located outside Devon but who were born in Devon

### 3 ENTRIES

- a) **Form of Entry:** Entries must be made on the form specified and signed by the Handicap Secretary of the player's Home Club
- b) **Enclosures:** The entry fee and, if appropriate a completed Parental Consent Form, must be sent with the completed entry form to the address shown below to arrive before the closing date
- c) **Refunds** will only be made in accordance with the General Conditions for Competitions

### 4 BALLOT

- a) **Field Size:** Where the entries exceed 72 in number, there will be a ballot amongst the highest handicaps to reduce the entries to that number

### 5 TROPHIES & PRIZE VOUCHERS

- a) Any Prizes for 'Two's' are NOT part of the competition
- b) Trophies may be retained by the Winner for the ensuing 12 months but must be kept within a NACOSS protected area at their Home Club for insurance purposes
- c) The Winner is responsible for having the trophy engraved at own expense
- d) The Winner shall return the Trophy when so requested by the Union
- e) Prize Vouchers will be given to the leading players as decided by the Committee
- f) The Trophies awarded are:
  - i) The Gold Medal - to player with the lowest gross score
  - ii) The Club Team Championship - to the nominated Club Team (3 players) with lowest combined gross score from the Gold Medal
  - iii) The Championship Challenge Cup - to Winner of the Amateur Championship
  - iv) The "Wish" Slater Salver - to the Winner of the 2<sup>nd</sup> 16 Matchplay event
