SW of ENGLAND MID-AMATEUR OPEN Information for Entrants

The General Conditions for Competitions (GCC) of the Devon County Golf Union apply to this competition. Refer to your club, the DCGU Website or the current DCGU Yearbook.

1 CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- a) **Format:** Medal. The competition shall be decided by stroke play over 36 holes
- b) **Winner:** The Winner shall be the competitor who returns the lowest gross score
- c) **Resolution of Ties:** In the event of a tie, the competition shall be decided by play-off
- d) **Motorised Buggies** - Entrants that require the use of a motorised buggy (or a motorised trolley in the event of abnormal ground conditions) in accordance with the terms of the Disability Discrimination Acts 1995 & 2005, shall submit a letter to the DCGU Office not less than 5 days in advance of the competition start date & include a Registered Medical Practitioner's Certificate. Refer to the General Conditions for Competitions for further information on use.

2 QUALIFICATION

- a) Entrants must be 35 years and over
- b) Entrants must have a playing:
 - i) a CONGU handicap not exceeding that shown on the Entry Form or
 - ii) a comparable handicap from a scheme operated by a recognised Overseas Golfing Union, Federation or Association (please advise details)

3 ENTRIES

- a) **Form of Entry:** Entries must be made on the form specified or 'On-Line' via the website.
- b) **Enclosures:** The entry fee and must be sent with the completed entry form to the address shown below to arrive before the closing date of the competition.
- c) **Refunds** will only be made in accordance with the General Conditions for Competitions.

4 BALLOT

- a) **Field Size:** Where the entries exceed 72 in number, there will be a ballot amongst the highest handicaps to reduce the entries to that number.

5 TROPHIES & PRIZE VOUCHERS

- a) The Trophies awarded are:
 - i) The Dartmoor Trophy - to player with the lowest gross score
- b) Trophies may be retained by the Winner for the ensuing 12 months but must be kept within a NACOSS protected area at their Home Club for insurance purposes
- c) The Winner is responsible for having the trophy engraved at his own expense
- d) The Winner shall return the Trophy when so requested by the Union
- e) Prize Vouchers will be given to the leading players as decided by the Committee
- f) Any Prizes for 'Two's' are NOT part of the competition
